EXTRACTS from ARTICLES of the HP/Agilent Retired Employees Club of Northern Colorado Bylaws

DUES

All members shall pay annual dues in such amount as shall be determined from time to time by resolution Of the Board of Directors. The first annual dues of each member shall be payable and submitted in full with his or her application for membership. Future annual dues shall be due and payable on January 1 of each year, and will become delinquent on April 1 of the next following year.

ELIGIBILITY FOR MEMBERSHIP

Any former HP or Agilent employee (including a former employee of an HP or Agilent acquisition who joins HP or Agilent and then retires or leaves HP or Agilent) is qualified for membership after satisfying at least one of the following conditions: (a) must have received at least ten (10) years of HP and/or Agilent service credit; (b) is presently on permanent disability and was working at HP and/or Agilent at the time of his/her permanent disability; (c) retired at age sixty (60) years or older without completing ten (10) years at HP and/or Agilent, or (d) is the surviving spouse or partner of a member in good standing at the time of such member's death. Additionally, in the event an individual either worked at least two (2) years for HP between 1939 and 1945 or has a situation not covered by the above, that individual can appeal to the Board for special consideration.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the HP/Agilent Retired Employees Club of Northern Colorado is the enjoyment and betterment of HP/Agilent retirees via social gatherings. The Retirees Club plans events such as cruises, tours, picnics, luncheons, and dinners, single and multiple day's excursions, as well as golf, bridge, hiking and Bible groups. Membership includes a newsletter published quarterly.
